




Edwards' Life (1703–1758)

- Connecticut River clergy
- * 1721 "a sense of the glory of the divine being"
- * 1722–1729 early pastorates
- * 1729 solo pastor in Northampton

- * 1740–1742 Great Awakening
- * 1748–1750 Communion controversy
- * 1751–1758 Stockbridge
- * 1758 Princeton, death
